

THIRD READING: Final Amendment

BYLAW NO. 291

A bylaw to amend Noowick Watermain Replacement Bylaw No. 286, 2021.

WHEREAS Noowick Watermain Replacement Bylaw No. 286, 2021 is hereby amended as follows:

There is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund of **One Million, Twenty-Two Thousand, Twenty Dollars and One Cent (\$1,022,020.01) as of 31 January 2022** which has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No. 281 (MBWD Capital Works, Renewal Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw) on the Noowick Road Watermain Replacement for design services in Mill Bay BC.

The Trustees of the Mill Bay Waterworks District **ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$70,000.00 (seventy thousand dollars) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund to be expended on design services for the Noowick Road Watermain Replacement in Mill Bay BC.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby authorized shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the **"MBWD Noowick Road Watermain Replacement Amendment Bylaw No. 291."**
