MILL BAY WATERWORKS DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 301

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund (38-A57R-A).

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund of **One million, Eight Hundred and Thirty-Four Thousand, Eight Hundred and Seven Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents** (\$1,834,807.37) as of 30 November 2023 which has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Fund on 31 December 2022	\$ 1,359,785.51
Additions/Deductions to Fund including interest earned as of November 30, 2023	\$ 710,021.86
Deduct: Total of disbursement bylaws	\$ 235,000.00
Balance in Trust Fund as of 30 November 2023	\$ 1,834,807.37

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend on the installation of two chlorine analyzers.

The Trustees of the Mill Bay Waterworks District **ENACT AS FOLLOWS**:

- The sum of \$20,000.00 (Twenty Thousand Dollars) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund (38-A57R-A) to be expended to purchase and install two inline chlorine analyzers for the water system.
- The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby authorized shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
- 3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "MBWD Chlorine Analyzer Bylaw No. 301."
