## MILL BAY WATERWORKS DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 317

A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund (38-A57R-A).

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund of **Two million, One Hundred and Fifty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty-Eight Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents** (\$2,152,938.67) as of 28 February 2025 which has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend on the installation of two chlorine analyzers.

The Trustees of the Mill Bay Waterworks District **ENACT AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The sum of \$11,421.91 (Eleven thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-One Dollars and Ninety-One Cents) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Renewal Reserve Fund (38-A57R-A) to be expended to purchase and install two inline chlorine, turbidity and PH analyzers for the water system.
- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby authorized shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
- 3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "MBWD Chlorine Analyzer Bylaw No. 317."
