Agenda to Include:

2023 Chair Report, 2022 Audited Financial Statements presented by Cory Vanderhorst (MNP LLP), elections to fill two (2) trustee positions, (for three year terms). Discussion to follow on topics such as the strategic plan, parcel tax and water conservation.

Voter Registration:

Voter registration will commence at 6:00 PM.

Trustee Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements to be a trustee on an Improvement District board are the same as the eligibility requirements to vote in an Improvement District election (see below). Trustee candidates are required to be nominated by two people during the meeting, a mover and seconder.

Nominator Eligibility:

There is no requirement that a nominator is an eligible elector. Nominators however *may not* be registered on the same title of land as of the nominee.

Vacant Trustee Positions

There are two (2) trustee positions available for election. If there are no more than two (2) persons nominated for the vacant positions, the positions will be filled by acclamation. If there are more than two (2) nominations, the election will occur during this Annual General Meeting. Persons standing for nomination are expected to give a brief biography of themselves during the meeting.

Voting:

Voting will only be required if more than two (2) persons have been nominated.

Voter Eligibility:

- Canadian citizen
- 18 years of age, or older
- A resident of BC for at least six months prior to the vote
- Own land in the improvement district

If more than one person is registered on title as a landowner, each person may vote as long as they meet the other voter eligibility requirements. Voters will be required to show ID and make a legal verbal statement on eligibility.

Each corporation or society that owns land within the improvement district has one vote and must designate, preferably in writing, a person to vote on its behalf. That person can also be an owner of other property in the improvement district. If so, that person could vote twice, once on their own behalf as a landowner and also as the agent authorized on behalf of the landowning corporation or society.

No person can have two votes unless they meet the qualifications to be an elector and are also designated as authorized agent to vote on behalf of a corporation.
